Goodwill* participates in the Building Pathways to Infrastructure Jobs Grant Program, funded by the U.S. Department of Labor. 

Learn how employment may impact your public benefits, participate in paid transitional work experience at real work sites or find a job with a variety of employers and get support in your new role.

Employment and Job Support

We work closely with job seekers and employers to connect people to a career with personalized, flexible job placement services.

DISABILITY SERVICES (CONT.)

ELEVATE Youth

A job exploration program helping youth learn about careers and skills to succeed at work (using experiential and team building activities to facilitate learning).

- Foundational job skills: Learn workplace skills that employers are looking for to support a foundation for success.
- Discover interests: Career discovery through assessments, online tools, guided discussions and hands-on activities. Instruction about in-demand occupations and the skills and training required.
- · Virtual reality experiences: Learners will experience a 'day in the life' from a wide range of careers available via a VR headset experience.
- Connect with employers: Hear directly from local employers through discussion panels, job tours, informational interviews and job fairs.
- Plan for success: Optional 1:1 personalized career exploration to develop goals and support for next steps.

Retail Skills Training

Retail skills training provides job skills to work in the retail industry. Classroom training is combined with paid work experience. This referral based program is not open to the general public.




